COVID LOCKDOWN has come again here in Uganda. For about two months we are not allowed to drive a vehicle, have regular services and all schools are closed. We are praying that this lockdown will end soon. We are able to have "social gatherings," "home Bible studies," and online services. We are also still going out

soul winning and seeing people baptized. My wife and I have been wanting to witness to our neighbors more and with walking places now we are able to do that. We have personally been able to lead several of our neighbors to the Lord. This past quarter, the Lord has allowed us to

see 457 people saved and 98 baptized.

RWANDA: The ministries in Rwanda are also having some challenges due to the lockdown there. Pastor Sadock is still working on constructing the church building in Kigali. Then last week we received an encouraging letter from Rwanda. Below are a few excerpts of the letter
